CHILDREN

Child price is applicable to children aged 18 months to 15 at the date of purchase. Persons aged 16 and over must purchase an adult ticket or concession if they hold relevant concession documents.

Children over the age of 18 months will need to have a seat purchased for them to be able to sit in reserved seat areas (eg Gold, Silver, Bronze).

A child aged 17 months and under is admitted free into the venue as long as they do not occupy a seat.

CONCESSION/PENSIONER

Concessions - includes all forms of concession:-

- i. **Pensioner Concession Card**
Aged, Carer, Aged Blind, Parenting Payment, Disability Support Pension, Partner Allowance, Widow Allowance, Widow Pension, Wife Pension, Newstart Allowance over 60 years.
- ii. **Health Care Card**
Newstart Allowance, Youth Allowance, Newstart Mature Age Allowance, Parenting Payment, Low Income, Carer Allowance, Partner Allowance, Mobility Allowance, Widow Allowance.
- iii. **Confirmation of Concession Card Entitlement Form**
- iv. **Personal Treatment Entitlement Card**
Commonwealth Seniors Cards are acceptable forms of concession entitlement. International students are not acceptable forms of concession entitlement.
- v. **Companion Card**
In accordance with the Equal Opportunity Act (1986) and the Disability Discrimination Act (1992) the Melbourne Cricket Club, Cricket Australia and Cricket Victoria aim to address their social and legal obligations by recognising that some patrons of the Melbourne Cricket Ground may not have access to cricket without being accompanied by a companion.
In accordance with this recognition, the recently introduced Companion Card is recognised for all cricket matches.
The patron with the Companion Card has to pay for his or her own entry. They will be entitled to a concession ticket if they have the appropriate concession identification. On presentation of the Companion Card, an additional ticket will be issued to the companion free of charge.

- vi. **Student Card**
All full time students studying in Australia, 16 years or over. Students studying internationally are not able to purchase a concession ticket with an International student card.

FAMILY

- Two (2) adults plus two (2) children aged 15 and under for general reserve/dry areas.
- Two (2) adults plus two (2) children over 18 months and under 15 years for reserve seating areas.

Members of this group **do not** have to be related.

MILO FAMILY ZONE

- **Vodafone Test Match and Commonwealth Bank Series One Day Internationals** – allocated seating area located in sections M28–M36 and Q29–Q36 of the Ponsford Stand.
- **KFC Twenty20 International** - allocated seating area located in sections N29–N36 (Silver), M28–M36 (Bronze) and Q29–Q36 (General Reserve) of the Ponsford Stand.

TRANSPORT**PUBLIC PARKING**
