**Agency Fees:**

A handling fee of \$6.15 inc. GST will apply for tickets purchased via the internet, phone, mail or fax. This does not apply to tickets purchased at outlets or at the gate on match day. Fee applies per transaction regardless of the number of tickets purchased.

Note: The same one-off handling fee of \$6.15 will apply to Family passes (2A2C), "Two Packs" and Test match passes when patrons purchase these via the phone, internet, mail or fax.

**GST:**

The prices listed above are inclusive of GST.

**Public Transport:**

Queensland Cricket has established an arrangement with CityTrans and TransLink for the 2011-12 season whereby every Ticketmaster ticket will provide free public bus and train travel to and from the Gabba for all international matches and KFC Big Bash League games. Free bus shuttles between the city and the Gabba will also operate before and after these matches, along with additional shuttle services from Eight Mile Plains, Carindale and Chermside.

Note that the free public transport services will also be valid for holders of corporate box tickets, BCG members' passes and Queensland Cricketers' Club passes. (*appendix 3 – match information*)

**Late gate Policy:**

As a general rule, Queensland Cricket will charge the following 'late gate' prices. Please note, these are subject to change on the day dependent on the circumstances. Prices include GST.

- Test Match - \$10 for adults and \$5 for children after tea (Note - this won't be applicable to a sell-out day)
- One Day International - \$10 for all people after 80 overs (Note - this won't be applicable to a sell-out match)

**Vodafone Test Match Pass:**

The Vodafone Test match pass provides admission to each day of the Vodafone Test match. Tickets are available from Ticketmaster only.

**Group Bookings:**

No group bookings during the Australian Cricket Family priority access period (15-21 August 2011).

10% discount for groups of more than ten (10) adult priced tickets – available from 22 August. Group discounts are available for advance sales only. Approval from Queensland Cricket is required. Please call the group bookings number - 1300 788 227

**Children:**

Queensland Cricket's policy is that children aged 4 or under will be admitted free only if they do not take up a dedicated seat. Other than for General Admission areas, parents should be advised that they will need to buy a children's ticket unless they are prepared to nurse the child on their lap for the entire day.

**Pensioner:**

Refers to any person with a "Pensioner Concession Card". They will be required to provide ID and present their card when purchasing or collecting a ticket.

**Concession/Part Pensioner:**

Includes full time students and all other pensioners that receive benefits, including holders of a "Health Care Card" (applies to Test, ODI, Twenty20 International and Domestic Twenty20 matches only), "State Seniors Card" and "Commonwealth Senior Health Card" i.e. discounts on medical, transport etc. They will also be required to provide ID and display their card when purchasing or collecting tickets.

**Family:**

Two (2) adults plus two (2) children aged 15 or under. Members of this group **do not** have to be related.

**MILO Family Zone:**

Located in section 72 of the Western Upper Stand and section 36 of the Western Lower Stand.

**Accessible Tickets:**

Contact Ticketmaster if you have wheelchair or special needs seating requirements.

**Carers:**

In the event that a mobility impaired patron is unable to attend without being accompanied by a carer, one carer will be supplied with a complimentary ticket. A ticket is required to be purchased for the impaired patron. Please contact Ticketmaster for further details. Carers must present their companion card.

**Australian Cricket Family (ACF) Priority Ticket Offer:**

Tickets are only available by phone or via the internet during the Australian Cricket Family priority ticket offer period (15-21 August 2011).

**Pass-Outs**

Pass-outs are available for all Gabba matches from gate opening time. For Ticketmaster ticketed matches, patrons are required to have their ticket barcode scanned prior to exiting the stadium and have it re-scanned upon entry back into the ground.

**LICENSED AND UNLICENSED AREAS**

There are designated 'licensed' and 'unlicensed' areas within the ground. There are signs that clearly indicate these areas. The areas are shown on the 'seating category' maps as depicted in Section 10 (Pricing). The areas inside the dotted red lines on these maps represent UNLICENSED areas. There are NO exchanges between licensed and unlicensed, customers must confirm their seating details at time of purchase.

**DISABLED/WHEELCHAIR PATRONS**

A limited amount of space is available within the Northern lower and Southern and Eastern upper for wheelchairs. The row of seats immediately in front of the wheelchair areas in the Northern lower and Southern upper have been held for sale to family & friends. One carer is allowed with each wheelchair / disabled patron.

**Carers** – in the event that a mobility-impaired patron is unable to attend without being accompanied by a carer, the carer can qualify for a free carer's ticket. Free entry is available for one carer upon presentation of their companion card.

Queensland Cricket supports the Companion Card Program in conjunction with the Queensland Government.

**SMOKING/NON-SMOKING AREAS**

The Brisbane Cricket Ground is a smoke free zone. Patrons who wish to smoke are required to exit the stadium to do so.

Smoking is not permitted within 4 metres of any entry or exit point to the stadium.

## SUN-AFFECTED AREAS IN THE GRANDSTANDS

Please be aware that certain areas within the Northern Stand lower deck and the Southern Stand (front 4-5 rows) receive direct sun at varying times during the day. The Eastern (lower, mid and upper) Stand is also sun-affected on occasions. Patrons are advised to wear sunscreen even when seated in a shaded area.

## CATERING

Food and beverage outlets and licensed bars are located throughout the stadium.

## MERCHANDISE

There are merchandising outlets located throughout the ground that sell the latest Cricket Australia and Bulls licensed product. Permanent facilities are located at Gates 2, 4, 7 and 9; portable booths are located on the upper levels in the breakout areas.

## CORPORATE FACILITIES / LEGENDS CLUB

Corporate Suites, Lounges and outdoor Boxes are available in the following packages: "Full Season", "Limited Season" or "International Season". They can also be purchased on a one-off basis for individual matches subject to availability.

The 'First XI', 'Champions Room' and 'Legends Club' function rooms provide club seating within a corporate area, with catering included, for the high-profile days of cricket (ie the Test match, One Day International, and Season Launch Twenty20).

'Straight Hit' provides prime corporate seating in the mid-tier of the Southern Stand, situated either side of the sightscreen, with catering excluded.
