



MyCricket Top Performer Competition

Terms & Conditions for the "Alinta Energy Cricket Australia MyCricket Top Performer" Competition (**Competition**)

1. Entrants to the Competition are taken to accept and agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
2. The Promoter of the Competition is Alinta Energy Retail Sales Pty Ltd (**Alinta Energy**) of Level 13, Grosvenor Place, 225 George Street, Sydney, NSW 2000. Phone: 02 9372 2600 (**Promoter**).
3. "Cricket Australia" is Cricket Australia (ABN 53 006 089 130) of 60 Jolimont Street, Jolimont, Victoria 3002.
4. The Competition commences at 09:00am (AEDT) on Monday 3 February 2020 and closes at 12:00pm (AEDT) on Sunday 8 March 2020 (**Competition Period**).
5. Subject to clause 6 of these Terms and Conditions, entry into (and winning) this Competition is only open to individuals (or their parent/guardian if under the age of 18) who are:
 - a. a resident of New South Wales, Queensland, Victoria or South Australia;
 - b. a registered participant on Cricket Australia's MyCricket platform (<https://mycricket.cricket.com.au/>);
 - c. has scored 50 or more runs in a single innings and/or taken 5 or more wickets in a single innings during a MyCricket registered game during the Competition Period; and
 - d. aged eighteen (18) years or older as at the time of entry into the Competition;
6. (**Eligible Entrant**).
 - a. An Eligible Entrant excludes any:
 - a. employee or agent of the Promoter; or
 - b. relative of an employee of the Promoter, being a spouse, parent, step-parent, sibling or child of that employee;

Entries received after this time will automatically be deemed as invalid. The time of the entry will be the time the entry form is received by the Promoter's database. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries due to technical disruptions, network congestions or any other reason.
8. Eligible Entrants must provide a valid MyCricket ID, residential address, email address and telephone number.
9. Only one entry is allowed per Eligible Entrant. Multiple instances of 50 or more runs or 5 or more wickets will not provide Eligible Entrants with additional entries or chances to win.
10. The draw will take place by random digital selection at 12:01pm (AEDT) on Monday 9 March 2020 and the winners will be notified by the email address provided in the entry form (**Draw**).
11. The first valid five-hundred (500) entries drawn will receive a single \$100 Rebel Sport e-Gift card (valued at \$100 and allocated at the Promoter's absolute discretion) (**Prize**).

Australian Cricket may disclose your personal information to other parties, including Australian Cricket's third party service providers. From time to time, these third parties may be located (and so your personal information may be disclosed) overseas, including in India, the USA and the UK, and other countries from time to time.
