Cricket Australia will verify each Eligible Club's details before an Eligible Club can participate in this Promotion.

Terms and Conditions of Entry for the ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2020 Community Clubs Anthem Kids and Flagbearer Promotion

First up

1. These terms and the Schedule form the Conditions of Entry for this Promotion, and set out all of the information you need to know regarding this Promotion. Capitalised terms have the meaning given in the Schedule, unless otherwise stated. If there's any inconsistency between these terms and the Schedule, then what's in the Schedule is correct. By submitting your entry, you agree that these Conditions of Entry apply to your entry.
2. The promoter is T20 World Cup 2020 Ltd ABN 14 618 113 269, of Level 2, 128 Jolimont Road, Jolimont, Victoria, 3002 (**'Promoter', 'we', 'us'**).
3. Any updates to these Conditions of Entry will be published on the website www.crickets.com.au/competitions, so it's important to check these Conditions of Entry regularly.

Who can enter ... and who can't

4. The eligibility requirements for this Promotion are set out in the Entry Restrictions. Directors, managers, employees, officers, agents and contractors of the Promoter, and their immediate families (ie spouse, partner, parent, grandparent, natural or adopted child, and sibling (whether natural or adopted by a parent)) are ineligible to enter.

How to enter

5. To enter, you must follow the Entry Procedure.
6. We will not accept entries which are incomplete, illegible, or which are generated by computers or other automated means (except in accordance with these Conditions of Entry).
7. We reserve the right to disqualify your entry in the event of non-compliance with these Conditions of Entry, failure to meet any content guidelines set out in the Entry Procedure, or if (in our reasonable opinion), you tamper or interfere with an entry mechanism in any way.
8. The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Prizes and further information will be emailed using the information provided to the Promoter, unless the winner provides an alternative email address at the time they are notified as being a winner. Prize winners should allow up to two weeks for delivery. We accept no responsibility for any misdirected mail.
18. If (having made reasonable efforts) we cannot contact a prize winner, or if any prize is not accepted or claimed by the Prize Claim Date, that prize winner's entry will be deemed invalid, and we reserve the right to distribute unclaimed prizes to the next best entry.
