Method of Scoring	<p>The method of scoring will involve answering questions correctly. The quicker that the participants answer the questions correctly the more points they will receive per question. The winner of the competitions will be the participant with the highest score at the end of each day, the end of each test and the end of the test series. The Scoring system is as per the scale below:</p> <p>Players will score 1000 points for a correct answer and additional 'speed points' depending on how fast they answer the question. Players will score 0 points for an incorrect answer and no additional 'speed points'. 'Speed points' are scored for answering correctly and will be given based on the percentage of time remaining of the 7 second time limit. Every one percent of time remaining increases the score by 10 points. Answering with 7 seconds remaining (100%) adds 1000 points and answering with 0.10 seconds (1%) adds 10 points. Players can score a minimum of 0 points and a maximum of 2000 points per question, with all players that answer incorrectly receiving 0 points and no 'speed points'. Players answering correctly can score a minimum of 1000 points and a max of 2000 points per answer, with 1000 points (speed points) available depending on how fast they answer with in the 7 second time limit.</p> <p>See examples of scoring below for a reference only.</p> <p><u>Player answers correctly with 72.5% of the 7 second time limit remaining</u> Correctly scoring 1 question = 1000 points Scoring with 72.5% of time remaining (out of 100%) = 725 points Total after 1 answer = 1725 points</p>
